1. Register for courses

- Register for courses on your Studentweb as soon as possible.
- Register for both classes and exams!
- When selecting courses, make sure that class schedules and examination timings do not overlap.
- Normal workload for one semester is 30 ECTS/30 Norwegian credit points.
- No exams, no credits!

- School exams – traditional exam in a classroom, with surveillance, usually four hours.
