

Professor Gunn Enli, Pro-Dean of the Faculty of Humanities, extends a warm welcome as you embark on the journey ahead!



### 1. Register for courses

- Register for courses on your Studentweb as soon as possible.
- Register for both classes and exams!
- When selecting courses, make sure that class schedules and examination timings do not overlap.
- Normal workload for one semester is 30 ECTS/30 Norwegian credit points.
- No exams, no credits!

### 2. Organize your Student ID and Student Card

Student identification, access to building and rooms and to do printouts.

- School exams traditional exam in a classroom, with surveillance, usually four hours.
- Make sure you don't have two examinations at the same time.
