EXAM QUESTION/TEXT:

Write **two** essays based on **two** of the following seven questions. Make sure to spend an approximately equal amount of words for both essays.

- 1. What makes a screen "screen"? Discuss.
- 2. What kinds of meanings and functions did the camera obscura acquire in early modern European thought?
- 3. Discuss the magic lantern's early history (until early nineteenth century) in relation to issues of imagination and illusion.
- 4. How did the stereoscope imply a "radical repositioning of the observer's relation to visual representation," according to Jonathan Crary?
- 5. What was significant to the panorama as a visual experience?
- 6. How did photography challenge the concept of visual representation?
- 7. How would you situate current machine learning practices in the longer history of screen cultures from the early modern period onwards?
