### **Participating in a conversation in Norwegian L2**

My research on everyday Polish-Norwegian conversation revealed that there are certain communicative practices that are frequently found in the L1 delivered speech, but seldom applied by the L2 speakers. In this presentation, the focus is on those practices that serve the function of displaying varying degrees of involvement in the conversation. I discuss how such practices can be used for performing agency in a communicative situation, and look into their potential relevance for workplace interaction.
