

Europarådets språkskala (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages – CEFR) slik den er gjengitt i spørreundersøkelsen:

A1 - Beginner: Recognise familiar words and basic phrases, answer simple questions, use simple phrases and sentences.

A2 - Pre-intermediate: Read short, simple texts, communicate routine tasks, handle social exchanges but find it difficult to keep the conversation going

B1 - Intermediate: Understand clear, standard speech on familiar topics, texts that consist of everyday language, enter unprepared conversations on topics that are familiar, describe experiences and events

B2 - Upper-Intermediate: Understand extended speech and lectures and follow complex lines of argument on reasonably familiar topics. Read articles and reports, interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity, take active part in discussion in familiar contexts. Present clear, detailed descriptions on a wide range of subjects.

C1 - Advanced: Understand wide range of demanding, longer texts, recognise implicit meaning, express yourself fluently and spontaneously, produce clear, well-structured, detailed texts on complex subjects, use language effectively for social and professional purposes.

C2 - Proficiency: Understand with ease virtually anything heard or read. Can summarise information from different sources, reconstructing arguments in a coherent presentation. Can express oneself spontaneously, very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning in complex situations
